I will give you the good news. The last three days Paul and the team have been able to use the Minister of Defense's ( a good friend of Paul's) sawmill.

They did more in the first day of sawing on his mill that they had done the previous four days on our mill. They are greatly encouraged with the number of boards that were sawed yesterday. The rest needed will have to come from our mill.

The boat has arrived at Bena Dibebe, the old riverport. The boat captain does not feel he can negotiate the next smaller Lubefu river with the large 600 ton barge on to Kela, the newer and closer riverport.

Ordinarily that would not be a problem EXCEPT there are two wooden bridges between Bena Dibebe and Lodja. Paul does not see how our large MAN truck can make it across these bridges!!

We ask your prayers that the boat could continue on up the Lubefu or that the Lord will give Paul wisdom in what to do about the truck.

Without the truck we cannot continue on to Katako Kombe with our supplies that are on the boat!
